Notice of Rejected Confidential Voter Registration Form and Early Voting Ballot Application Containing a Defect that May be Corrected

Section Reference:

Sections 13.002(e), 82.007, 84.0021, 84.003, 86.008 Texas Election Code

Purpose:

To notify a voter who participates in the Texas Attorney General Confidentiality program that the application that was submitted is not able to be accepted because of a defect(s). The defect must be corrected by having the voter personally return to the Early Voting Clerk's office no later than the 11th day before election day to correct the defect(s).

Number of Copies Required:

Two recommended – One copy is mailed to the voter and the other copy is placed with the voter's defective application to await corrective action.

Completed by:

Early Voting Clerk

Filing Date:

Immediately after the Early Voting Clerk determines that the voter's application must be rejected

Filed With:

The voter who filed the Confidential Voter Registration Form and Early Voting Ballot Application

Comments:

A defect on a voter's Confidential Voter Registration Form and Early Voting Ballot Application can only be corrected at the Early Voting Clerk's Office by the voter. The voter must appear in person at the Early Voting Clerk's Office by the 11th day before Election Day to correct the defect(s). Only the voter may correct his or her own personal application.
