The Primary Election has already started.

- We are 62 days from election day.
- We are 48 days away from the first day of early voting.
- We are 17 days away from mail ballots being sent out.



What should be completed?

- Joint Primary Agreements and Primary Contracts
- Candidate Filings and Ballot Drawing
 - Party Chairs should confirm with County Election Officials if there are any pending challenges.
- Ballots
 - Advisory 2023-27 – Ballot Preparation and Sample Ballots for the March 5, 2024 Primary Election
- Election Supplies
- List of Registered Voters
- Election Judges



What should we be thinking about?

- Finding Workers and Back-Up Workers
- Finalizing Ballots
 - Last day to challenge application for form, content, and procedure: January 16, 2024
- L&A Testing
 - Recommended deadline: January 17, 2024
- Preparing to mail out ballots
 - UOCAVA Voters (FPCA) Deadline: January 20, 2024
- Submitting your itemized estimates and requests
 - Deadline : January 22, 2024
