Notice of Carrier Defect Issued by the Early Voting Clerk (Your Ballot by Mail is Being Held at the Early Voting Clerk's Office Awaiting Correction)

Section Reference:

Section 86.011(d), Texas Election Code

Purpose:

To inform the voter of a defect(s) with his or her Carrier Envelope and provide instructions about the Corrective Action Process.

Number of Copies Required:

Two copies are recommended. One copy must be sent to the voter. The other copy should be attached to the Carrier Envelope Awaiting Correction.

Completed By:

Early Voting Clerk

Filing Date:

The Early Voting Clerk must send the voter this notice within two days of identifying the defect(s).

Filed With:

The voter who returned his or her Carrier Envelope.

Comments:

The Early Voting Clerk has the authority to act according to Section 86.011(d), Texas Election Code.

The Early Voting Clerk must apply these procedures uniformly to all voters in similar circumstances.
