<u>Type of pre-service training</u>	<u>When the caregiver must complete the training</u>
(1) <u>General Pre-Service required in (a)(1) in Figure: 26 TAC §749.863(a)</u>	<u>Before you issue the non-expiring foster home verification, unless you waive the training requirement according to §749.868 of this chapter (relating to Can a child-placing agency waive pre-service training requirements for a foster parent?).</u>
(2) <u>Normalcy required in (a)(2) in Figure: 26 TAC §749.863(a)</u>	<u>Before you issue the non-expiring foster home verification unless you waive the training requirement according to §749.868 of this chapter.</u>
(3) <u>Emergency Behavior Intervention, if you do not allow the use of emergency behavior intervention, required in (a)(3) in Figure: 26 TAC §749.863(a)</u>	<u>Before you issue the non-expiring foster home verification, unless:</u> <u>(A) The caregiver is exempt because the caregiver cares exclusively for children receiving treatment services for primary medical needs; or</u> <u>(B) You waive the training requirement according to §749.868 of this chapter.</u>
(4) <u>Emergency Behavior Intervention, if you allow the use of emergency behavior intervention required in (a)(4) in Figure: 26 TAC §749.863(a)</u>	<u>According to the time frames in (a)(4)(C) in in Figure: 26 TAC §749.863(a), unless:</u> <u>(A) The caregiver is exempt because the caregiver cares exclusively for children receiving treatment services for primary medical needs; or</u> <u>(B) You waive the training requirement according to §749.868 of this chapter.</u>
(5) <u>Safe Sleeping required in (a)(5) in Figure: 26 TAC §749.863(a)</u>	<u>If kinship foster home will care for a child younger than two years of age, according to the time frames in (a)(5)(C) in in Figure: 26 TAC §749.863(a).</u>
(6) <u>Administering Psychotropic Medication in (a)(6) in Figure: 26 TAC §749.863(a)</u>	<u>Before the caregiver administers psychotropic medication.</u>
